In addition, Westlaw and LexisNexis have briefs from the U.S. Supreme Court; consult the directories of each service for coverage.

The Harvard Bluebook (REF/RES KF 245 .U55), and various court rules (RES/OTHER LOCATIONS) should be consulted as appropriate.
