

CI-LIRR BUS SERVICE
(Effective 11/9/09)

Touro Shuttle: Touro provides free shuttle bus service to and from the Central Islip Long Island Railroad (LIRR) station, at key times coordinated with the arrival of eastbound trains and the departure of westbound trains. The trip takes ten minutes.

CI LIRR TO TOURO

Monday-Friday 9:00, 9:40 and 10:40 a.m. Picking up passengers from the eastbound trains arriving at 8:51, 9:32 and 10:30 a.m.

Monday-Thursday 6:18 p.m. Picking up passengers from the eastbound trains arriving at 5:50, 5:58 and 6:13 p.m.

TOURO TO CI LIRR

Monday-Thursday 4:40, 7:00, 7:50, 9:00 and 10:05 p.m. Meeting the westbound trains arriving at 4:55, 7:20, 8:05, 9:18 and 10:18 p.m.

NEW Friday 1:00 and 2:00 p.m. Meeting the westbound trains departing at 1:15 and 2:15 p.m.

Public Transportation: Suffolk County Transit provides regularly scheduled bus service between Touro and the Central Islip LIRR station, Monday-Saturday from early morning to about 7:00 p.m. The trip takes 10-15 minutes and costs \$1.50 (exact change required). Going from the station to Touro, the 3C bus picks up on Suffolk Avenue just outside the station and stops in front of the building. The bus from Touro to the station stops on the New York Institute of Technology (NYIT) campus and continues to CI LIRR. The complete schedule is at the end of this memo. The LIRR trip to Penn Station in Manhattan takes about an hour and 10 minutes. Daily roundtrip fare is \$21.50-\$30, depending on day and time - less if you buy your tickets on-line.
